



Who Am I?

- 10 Points** I was born on 4th August 1961 in Honolulu, Hawaii
- 9 Points** My parents separated when I was two years old and in 1967, my mother re-married and we moved to Indonesia to live
- 8 Points** When I was ten, I returned to Honolulu to live with my maternal grandparents until I graduated from high school in 1979
- 7 Points** In 1983, I graduated from Columbia University, New York, with a B.A. in political science. I then went on to work at Business International Corporation and New York Public Interest Research Group
- 6 Points** In 1988, I entered Harvard Law School and at the end of my first year was selected as an editor of the law review based on my grades and a writing competition
- 5 Points** My first book *Dreams From My Father* was published in mid-1995.
- 4 Points** I taught constitutional Law at the University of Chicago Law School for twelve years from 1992 - 2004
- 3 Points** In 1993, I joined Davis, Miner, Barnhill & Galland, a 12-attorney law firm, where I was an associate for three years
- 2 Points** In 1996, I was elected to the Illinois Senate, succeeding State Senator Alice Palmer as Senator from the 13th District and resigned in November 2004 following my election to the US Senate
- 1 Point** In 2008 I became the Democratic Party candidate for the US Presidential election beating Hilary Clinton
